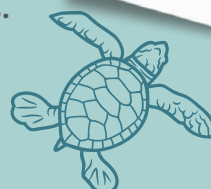

On our day off, we'll have **time to explore the other natural wonders of Costa Rica**. We may visit the nearby national park Corcovado, take a boat to look for dolphins, or take a day trip to Isla del Caño.

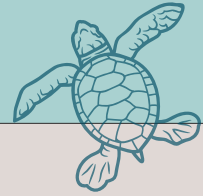

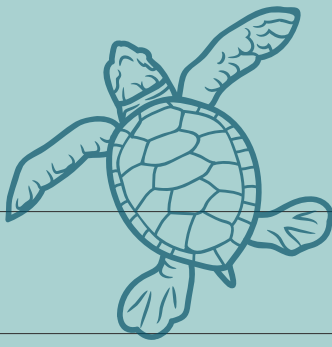

**DAY OFF\*** **TBD** (Dolphin & Whale Tour, Tour Exploring Corcovado National Park, or Snorkelling Tour to Isla del Caño)

**DAY 12** (NOV 28) **DEPARTURE** from Sea Turtle Conservation Project, **Last Night** in the Central Valley together
